Providing support for youth violence and hospital discharge projects enabling individual and groups of young people to take part in positive therapeutic activities and have their voices heard. Partnership working and relationship development are essential.

Fuelled by a belief that dance and movement should be accessible to all I founded and grew a not-for-profit dance centre engaging young people who would not traditionally have a pathway into dance. I created the brand, logo, website and marketing ideas. Managing a team of instructors and assistants across multiple sites, teaching over 100 dancers weekly, hosting annual shows with audiences of more than 400 people, again, many of whom would not traditionally engage in dance and theatre.

### West Sussex County Council, Youth Worker 2004 - 2011

I worked with a range of young people and engaged them in informal education and positive activities. I established Vibe - a youth dance company - and ran a village youth club. A confident approach to other agencies and services, was a necessity.

### Highbury College, Dance/Physical Theatre Lecturer 2007 - 2008

Creating course content, planning and delivering sessions, evaluating and grading course work and final assessments. I also had to structure termly programmes for different years and levels and provide tutorials and extra support where needed.
